I, Sandra DePriest, hereby reply to the unauthorized "Comments on Responses to 3 FCC Sec 308 Letters" (Havens' Comments) filed in the above-captioned matters on October 2, 2009 by Warren Havens, Skybridge Spectrum Foundation, Environmental LLC, Intelligent Transportation and Monitoring Wireless LLC, Verde Systems LLC, and Telesaurus Holdings GB LLC (collectively, Havens). I appreciate Havens' prompt filing of his unauthorized Comments, thereby closing these matters and allowing the Commission to act without further delay.

Havens' Comments are so convoluted, confused and irrelevant that I am unable to respond in detail. I deny that I did not directly and fully respond to the Commission's inquiry and I deny that any of my responses was spurious. I believe that I have provided the Commission with all of the information which it requested, but I stand ready to respond to any further inquiry which the Commission may have.

In a message to Havens on August 25, 2009, Scot Stone, Deputy Chief, Mobility Division, informed Havens that any submission such as Havens' Comments would be an unauthorized pleading and that he was advised to concurrently seek leave to file an unauthorized pleading. Because Havens' failed to request leave concurrently, the Commission should dismiss his Comments without consideration.

This letter is in response to your letter of August 18, 2009 requesting additional information concerning the interests and involvement of Mr. Donald R. DePriest with MariTEL and Maritime Communications/Land Mobile, LLC (MC/LM). As you are aware, Mr. DePriest is my husband, and Dennis C. Brown represents both of us in our FCC activities. While I have been referred to by Warren Havens as an FCC Attorney, I have not been involved in the active practice of law since 1996, other than the pro bono representation of several charitable organizations in the filing of their tax exempt applications. Other than my involvement with MC/LM since 2005, and the operation of a Choctaw Bed & Breakfast, Inc. in Natchez, Mississippi since 2006, I have been associated with the ministry since 1996, and I am an ordained Episcopal Priest serving a church part-time.

Question 1. Identify and describe all business entities, of whatever form, that have been controlled by Mr. DePriest during the relevant period. For purposes of this question, Mr. DePriest should be deemed to have controlled any entity in which he held a 50.0% or more ownership interest, or served as a director or officer, or served as a general partner, or exercised *de facto* control in any way at any time during the relevant period.
