On April 27, 2010, Bill Goodwyn, President, Domestic Distribution and Enterprises for Discovery Communications, LLC ("Discovery"), and the undersigned, Senior Vice President, Public Policy & Government Relations for Discovery, met with Sherrese Smith, legal advisor for media, consumer, and enforcement issues for Chairman Genachowski regarding the above-captioned docket.

During the meeting, the parties discussed the issues raised in the Petition for Rulemaking, the impact that the current retransmission consent scheme has on the ability of programmers not affiliated with must-have broadcasters to gain carriage on reasonable terms and conditions, and the need for the Commission to protect diversity of voice on MVPD offerings. They also discussed the various remedial options proposed in the Petition.
