On April 29, 2010, representatives of The Boeing Company (“Boeing”) gave a guided tour of its flight test facilities at Boeing Field in Seattle, Washington to Charles Mathias, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Meredith Attwell Baker and Paul de Sa, Chief of the Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis. Participating in the tour for Boeing were Dennis O’Donoghue, Frank Weaver, Audrey Allison, Keith Wing and Rich White.

During the tour of Boeing’s facilities, telemetry rooms and a 787 test aircraft, the flight testing process and requirements were discussed, as well as the importance of protecting safety-of-life flight test spectrum from harmful interference.
