
This is to inform you that, on April 29, 2010, Vincent Sadusky, CEO of LIN Media (“LIN”), Rebecca Duke, LIN’s Vice President of Distribution, and I met with Julius Knapp, Alan Stillwell, and Walter Johnson of the Office of Engineering and Technology and William Lake and Rebecca Hanson of the Media Bureau.

We discussed the National Broadband Plan’s recommendation that broadcast spectrum be reallocated for broadband service. Mr. Sadusky emphasized that the FCC’s broadcast ownership rules and its inflexible technical regulations hinder efforts of television broadcasters to adapt to the changing needs and expectations of consumers. Mr. Sadusky said that with increased technical flexibility and relaxation of the broadcast ownership rules, television broadcasters could better provide the kinds of services envisioned for mobile devices in the National Broadband Plan.
