Central Scott Telephone Co., Inc. (CSTC) hereby provides notice that it intends to cease offering wireline broadband Internet access service on a tariffed basis. Effective July 1, 2010, CSTC will begin offering wireline broadband Internet access service on a Title II, common carriage, permissive detariffed basis pursuant to paragraph 94 of the Federal Communications Commission's Wireline Broadband Order.¹ The geographic areas affected are those CSTC exchanges where DSL is technically feasible.

CSTC provides this service as a component of Internet service to its Digital Subscriber Line end users. The end user service provided will not be affected by discontinuance of the tariffed offering by CSTC. In compliance with the FCC requirements, CSTC sent a letter to all customers dated 5/10/10 (see attached letter). CSTC will continue to offer services to existing customer(s) under current rates, terms and conditions until the end of their current term or upon replacement with a Broadband Commercial Agreement. Broadband Commercial Agreements will be made available in a nondiscriminatory manner to any provider desiring to purchase wireline broadband access service for use as a component in its broadband Internet service sold to consumers.


Effective July 1, 2010, CSTC will make its wireline broadband Internet access service on a permissive detariffed, common carriage basis through posting of rates, terms and conditions at www.centralscott.com. 

Central Scott Telephone Customer,

Effective July 1, 2010, Central Scott Telephone Company will begin to provide DSL Access Services on a detariffed basis to our valued customers. There will be no impact to your current pricing or level of service.

Central Scott Telephone DSL Internet Access Services are provided in the Eldridge, Donahue, and McCausland exchanges. These combined telephone exchanges serve the Iowa communities of Eldridge, Long Grove, Park View, Donahue, and McCausland.

A tariff filing will be made by the National Exchange Carrier Association (NECA) with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) on 15 days notice effective July 1, 2010 to remove DSL Access services from NECA's Tariff FCC No. 5.
