Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 1.1409 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. §1.1409, we request that you provide the information specified below together with your response to the above-referenced complaint. We need the requested information to resolve the issues raised in this matter expeditiously and to facilitate verification of the accuracy of data set forth in the pleadings.

By way of background, Section 1.1404(g) of the Rules, 47 C.F.R. §1.1404(g), provides that data should be derived from FERC Form 1 or other identified reports filed with state or federal regulatory agencies. Therefore, we ask that you furnish copies of the pages from FERC Form 1 corresponding to the information listed in the attachment.

Also provide copies of accounting and other records for all such alternate accounts, subaccounts and data. Such copies should be clearly labeled, identifying the source and date of the information. In addition, where subaccounts are used, provide records of the complete account(s) in which such subaccounts are maintained.
