On May 12, 2010, Tom Sugrue, Eric Hagerson, Chris Wiczorek, and the undersigned of T-Mobile met with Julius Knapp, Bruce Romano, Ira Keltz, Walter Johnson, John Kennedy, and Jamison Prime, of the Office of Engineering and Technology, and Robert Alderfer and Tom Peters of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau to discuss the Commission's efforts to identify additional federal spectrum for wireless broadband deployment.

The T-Mobile discussed the benefits of pairing the AWS-3 band with spectrum currently occupied by the federal government in the 1755-1780 MHz band. T-Mobile expressed its hope that collaboration between NTIA and the FCC will result in an identification of at least 20 MHz of spectrum in this band for reallocation and auction by the October 1 deadline set in the National Broadband Plan.
