We discussed the National Broadband Plan and reviewed some of the principal recommendations that Sprint Nextel has made. Specifically, we reviewed Sprint Nextel's policy recommendations with respect to the 700 MHz D Block, the 1.9 GHz H Block, and cost-recovery as a result of the Broadcast Auxiliary Service transition. For each of these proceedings, we noted that the record was well developed and urged the Commission to resolve the outstanding issues as quickly as possible.
