Commissioner Baker-I am faxing you regarding the FCC docket [REDACTED] 10-51. This is the proposal that the FCC is seeking to make disastrous cuts to VRS.

I am an American Sign Language interpreter and this would mean that I would be out of a job as well as 5,000+ of my colleagues both interpreters and Deaf Americans.

The cut to \$3.89/min for large providers is not equitable for companies that provide the BULK of this interpreting service to deaf people. It is the choice of the Deaf person which company they want to choose and they choose what works best for them and where they can get the highest quality interpreters. If this is passed- they will not have that choice- or access- or functional equivalency any more.

Mothers will not be able to speak to their children, grandparents never able to talk to their grandchildren. Doctors provide test results, deaf people be able to use the phone like anyone else. We provide (and were the FIRST) to provide 911 to deaf people- it has saved many lives.

The loss of this service will silence the Deaf community of America-again. It will strip them of equal access, it will impeded on their inalienable rights as Americans.

Please come to a rate that is fair and equitable for all companies involved so that VRS can continue to make the world accessible to Deaf people.





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
