
On behalf of the Robert M. Post Marital Trust, dated April 6, 1999 ("Trust") and Jeffrey S. Leslie ("Mr. Leslie"), their pending application for streamlined transfer of control of the domestic blanket Section 214 authorization of ITS Telecommunications Systems, Inc. ("ITS"), filed May 4, 2010, is clarified as follows:

1. Mr. Leslie has no current ownership interests in any entities that offer domestic telecommunications services, and no current employment or management interests in any entities that offer domestic telecommunications services other than those entities listed in Section (7) of the subject application.

2. Applicants believe that the application qualifies for presumed streamlined treatment pursuant to Section 63.03(b)(1)(ii) of the Commission's Rules because the Transferee, Mr. Leslie, is not a telecommunications provider.
