



**Notice of Permissive Detariffing of Wireline Broadband Internet Access Service
Effective July 1, 2010
CC Docket No. 02-33
April 29, 2010**

South Canaan Telephone Company ("Company") hereby provides notice that it plans to terminate provision of wireline broadband Internet access service (WBIAS) on a tariff basis effective July 1, 2010 at which time it plans to offer permissive detariffed WBIAS on a Title II common-carriage basis pursuant to paragraph 94 of the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC") *Wireline Broadband Order*. The Company currently offers WBIAS through Asymmetric Digital Subscriber Line ("ADSL") Access Service under NECA's Tariff F.C.C No. 5.

In order to effect the permissive detariffing, NECA will make a tariff filing with the FCC on June 16, 2010 on 15 days notice to remove the Company from its Tariff F.C.C No. 5 ADSL Access Services (hereinafter "WBIAS") under the tariff effective July 1, 2010.

Impact on Customers

The only customer for the Company's WBIAS is the Company's affiliate nonregulated Internet Service Provider ("ISP") operation. The affiliate purchases WBIAS for use as a component in its broadband Internet service sold to consumers and business customers. The discontinuance of the tariff offering of WBIAS will have no effect on the end user service provided by the affiliate.

Serving Area

The Company's provision of WBIAS is limited to its ILEC serving area in northeast Pennsylvania, the South Canaan and Waymart exchanges. Its Study Area Code is 170204.

Future Availability of WBIAS on a Permissive-Detariffed Common Carriage Basis

The Company will continue to make WBIAS available on a common-carriage basis. Rates, terms and conditions of service will be available at the Company's business office located at 2175 Easton Turnpike, South Canaan, PA 18459, and by telephone at (570) 937-4114. The Company will also display the appropriate information on their website at www.socantel.net. As required by the FCC, the Company will continue to make available to its existing customer rates, terms and conditions consistent with the current tariffed rates on a grandfathered basis pursuant to the aforementioned FCC's *Wireline Broadband Order*.
