Dear Ms. Dortch:

On May 18, 2010, John Chambers, Chairman and Chief Executive Officer, Michael Timmeny, Vice President, Corporate Government Affairs, and the undersigned met with Chairman Julius Genachowski and Chief of Staff Edward Lazarus to discuss the classification of broadband Internet access services, the open Internet, and set top box regulation.

The topics discussed at this meeting were consistent with Cisco's past filings in these dockets. Specific topics discussed included: the potential negative impact of reclassification of broadband Internet access services on investment in broadband infrastructure, job creation and economic growth; the international perception of reclassification as regulation of the Internet, leading to global Internet regulation problems; possible legislative and regulatory alternatives to reclassification; the need to find a consensus on open Internet regulation acceptable to all sides of the debate; and the negative impact of potential set top box regulation that could increase consumer costs and limit consumer choice by picking technology winners and prohibiting the deployment of integrated set top boxes.
