

Ohio AT&T Litigation. In prior status reports, Intrado has noted that an appeal of an arbitration decision rendered by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (the “PUCO”) was pending in the Southern District of Ohio concerning Intrado’s arbitration with AT&T Ohio.¹ As noted in the Twenty-Seventh Consolidated Status Report, on April 6, 2010, Intrado, AT&T, and the PUCO filed briefs on the merits with the District Court. On April 27, AT&T filed a reply brief on the merits. AT&T’s brief is set forth in **Attachment A**. On May 4, Intrado submitted a notice of supplemental authority to the District Court, attached hereto as **Attachment B**. AT&T responded Intrado’s notice of supplemental authority on May 7, which response is attached hereto as **Attachment C**.

North Carolina AT&T Litigation. Intrado has noted that an appeal of an arbitration decision rendered the North Carolina Utilities Commission (the “NCUC”) was pending in the Eastern District of North Carolina regarding Intrado’s arbitration with AT&T North Carolina.² On April 26, Intrado, AT&T, and the NCUC filed motions for summary judgment and memoranda in support of motions with the District Court. These motions and their accompanying memoranda are attached hereto as **Attachment D**, **Attachment E**, and **Attachment F**, respectively.

Verizon Matters. Intrado is engaged in ongoing negotiations with Verizon North Inc., Verizon Florida, LLC, GTE Southwest Incorporated, Verizon South Inc., Verizon Pennsylvania Inc., and Verizon Virginia Inc. (collectively, “Verizon”), regarding interconnection and state arbitration proceedings between Intrado and Verizon in Texas, Delaware, Florida, Illinois,

Pennsylvania, and North Carolina. The parties continue to discuss compromise agreements covering operations in these states.

Texas Verizon Arbitration. As noted in the Twenty-Eighth Consolidated Status Report, on April 16, both Intrado and Verizon filed Direct Testimony in the parties' arbitration before the Public Utility Commission of Texas (the "PUCT").³ On May 10, both Intrado and Verizon filed rebuttal testimony with the PUCT, attached hereto as **Attachment G** and **Attachment H**, respectively. The parties also engaged in a pre-hearing conference in the arbitration proceeding before the PUCT on May 13; a notice of the conference is set forth as **Attachment I**. On May 18, the PUCT issued an Order requesting a videotaped demonstration of Intrado's service as it would operate in Texas. The PUCT's Order is set forth as **Attachment J**.

Pennsylvania Verizon Interconnection Agreement. On April 29, Intrado and Verizon Pennsylvania Inc. filed an executed interconnection agreement covering the State of Pennsylvania for approval by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission. A copy of the filed agreement is attached hereto as **Attachment K**.

Other Verizon Matters. There has been no activity in the state arbitration proceedings between Intrado and Verizon in Florida, Illinois, North Carolina, and Delaware since the last status report.


Embarq Matters. As noted in the Twenty-Eighth Consolidated Status Report, Intrado is engaged in ongoing negotiations with Central Telephone Company of Virginia and United Telephone – Southeast, Inc. (collectively, "Embarq"), including the status of other state
