
Dear Ms. Dortch:

Representatives of Sprint Nextel Corporation and Clearwire Corporation met yesterday with John Guisti, Chief of Staff and Legal Advisor for Wireless, Public Safety, and International to Commissioner Michael Copps, and Frank Gonzalez, who is also affiliated with the office of Commissioner Copps. Lawrence Krevor, Richard Engelman and Trey Hanbury represented Sprint Nextel. Christopher Murray represented Clearwire.

The parties discussed the importance of the 4G ecosystem both domestically and internationally and then addressed the importance of promoting wireless competition in next-generation mobile broadband networks. We specifically encouraged the Commission to auction the 700 MHz D Block in a manner that promotes competition and consumer choice.
