

I read in the local newspaper that the FCC is looking for 10,000 volunteers for speed testing of their broadband connections. The above proceeding seems to be the closest item to this topic I could find, especially since the article mentioned the survey results in the document DA-10-670A1. I would be happy to be such a volunteer. I have a nominal 1.5 Mb/s DSL line through Netzero using the AT&T phone line to my house at the above address. I have no proprietary interest in the companies involved or the service (except as a user). I think one of the IC design companies I have worked for in my career made DSL circuits, but I was not involved in those designs. I have worked on 10Gb (and lower rate) Ethernet devices, and on the IEEE committees involved in the 10Gb standards, though not since retiring a few years ago, so have some technical background in the field, though not on DSL devices explicitly.
