Dear Ms. Dortch:

By this letter and in accordance with paragraph 101 of the Federal Communication Commission's *Report and Order* and *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* CC Docket Nos. 02-33 and 01-337 released September 23, 2005, FCC 05-150 ("*Broadband Internet Order*"), the Windstream Local Operating Companies ("Windstream") identified in Attachment A hereby notify the Commission that Windstream intends to discontinue offering common carrier Digital Subscriber Line (DSL) service on a common carriage basis and will offer this service on a private carriage basis effective July 1, 2010. Windstream Lexcom, Inc. currently offers DSL on a common carriage tariff basis from the NECA Tariff FCC No. 5. The geographic areas affected by this change are the areas serviced by the companies listed in Attachment A where DSL is available.


Neither the provisioning of nor the current rates for these services will be affected by this action. 

Notice of Deregulation of DSL Service Effective July 1, 2010

This notice is an informational notice only, required by the FCC. **No action is required on your part.** The services and rates for your current DSL service are not changing. Windstream is required to notify you of its intent to discontinue providing DSL service on a tariffed basis from the National Exchange Carrier Association Tariff F.C.C. No. 5. This notice fulfills that requirement.

Re: Notice of Removal of DSL from National Exchange Carrier Association Tariff F.C.C. No. 5. By this letter and in accordance with paragraph 101 of the Federal Communications Commission's Report and Order and Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in CC Docket Nos. 02-33 and 01-337 released September 23, 2005, FCC 05-150 ("Broadband Internet Order"), the Windstream Companies ("Windstream") identified below hereby provide notice that Windstream intends to discontinue offering common carrier Digital Subscriber Line (DSL) service on a tariffed basis from National Exchange Carrier Association Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 effective July 1st, 2010. Windstream will offer DSL on a private carriage basis. The geographic areas affected by this change are the areas serviced by the companies listed below where DSL is available.

The terms and conditions for Windstream DSL service will be available on the Windstream website (<http://www.windstream.com>) effective June 30, 2010 and will also be available for review at Windstream's corporate office located at 4001 Rodney Parham Rd., Little Rock, Arkansas 72212.
