I am writing to voice my opposition to the proposed Comcast-NBC merger.

A merger of this size will give one company unprecedented control over media content and platforms, allow the largest cable and Internet access provider to control one of the nation's largest media companies, and give Comcast-NBC an incentive to prioritize its own online content over other content and stifle the free flow of Internet traffic.
