On June 7, 2010, Cristina Pauzé of Time Warner Cable and I met with Brad Gillen, Millie Kerr, and Henry Greenidge of the Office of Commissioner Baker to discuss the petition for rulemaking pending in the above-captioned docket. During this meeting, we discussed the Commission's authority under Sections 325 and 309 of the Communications Act to address the mounting consumer harms caused by the problems afflicting the retransmission consent process. We also reiterated Time Warner Cable's support for promptly initiating a rulemaking proceeding to adopt reforms that would protect consumers from the constant threat of service disruptions and cost increases.
