Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 8, 2010, Mike Maddix, Director of Government and Regulatory Affairs of Sorenson Communications, Inc. (“Sorenson”), Toni Cook Bush of Skadden, Arps, Slate, Meagher & Flom, LLP, counsel for Sorenson, and Greg Lawler and the undersigned of Lawler, Metzger, Keeney & Logan, LLC, also counsel for Sorenson, met separately with Angela Kronenberg, legal advisor to Commissioner Clyburn; Christi Shewman, legal advisor to Commissioner Baker; and Paul de Sa, Chief of the Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis.

During the meetings, Sorenson discussed confidential documents regarding the company’s costs of providing VRS that had been previously submitted to Ms. Kronenberg, Ms. Shewman, and Mr. de Sa under a request for confidential treatment.¹ During the meetings with Ms. Kronenberg and Ms. Shewman, Sorenson also distributed and discussed an overview of the company’s record of success in advancing the goals of the Americans with Disabilities Act, and a table from the May 30, 2010 filing in which the National Exchange Carrier Association proposed four “VRS Rate Alternatives” for the period after June 30, 2010.² Copies of these handouts are attached hereto.
