Meeting Summary: The Chair welcomed everyone to the eighth meeting of IWG-1, and participants introduced themselves. The agenda (Document IWG-1/30) was approved. Brennan Price (ARRL) volunteered to draft the minutes of this meeting. The minutes of the January 25, 2010 meeting of IWG-1 (Document IWG-1/29) were corrected to add Tom Hayden to the list of participants. The corrected minutes were approved.

Raafat Nasser provided a report of developments at the recently concluded ASMG meeting in Tunis. Brennan Price reported that the CITELE PCC.II meeting scheduled for April had been postponed, and that the date of the next CITELE PCC.II meeting was to be determined. It was reported that the next WAC meeting would likely to be in time for the August PCC.II meeting.

The group then considered contributions under the various WRC agenda items as follows:

**Agenda Item 1.3** – (*UAS*) – There was no update for this agenda item.

**Agenda Item 1.4** – (*AM(R)S*) – There was no update for this agenda item.

**Agenda Item 1.9** – (*Appendix 17*) – There was no update for this agenda item.

**Agenda Item 1.10** – (*Ship and Port Safety*) – An NTIA proposal for a mobile-satellite service (Earth-to-space) allocation for Appendix 18 channels 75 and 76 to support satellite detection of AIS was discussed. Consideration of this item was tabled until the next meeting, at which time it is expected that IWG-1 will develop a position.

**Agenda Item 1.12** – *(37-38 GHz Band)* – Under this agenda item it was noted that the proposal previously approved by IWG-1, Document IWG-1/28, had been approved by the WAC.

**Agenda Item 1.14** – *(30-300 MHz Radiolocation)* – Brennan Price introduced Document IWG-1/31, proposing a no change underscore position on this item. Brennan Price suggested that the desired applications as stated in the supporting resolution were already accommodated in radiolocation allocations in the 420 - 450 kHz band. Walter Sonnenfeldt suggested he may provide some content regarding needed protection for space services. This document was tabled for further discussion at the next IWG-1 meeting.

**Agenda Item 1.15** – *(3-50 MHz Radiolocation)* – Raafat Nasser reported that ASMG supports an allocation for this agenda item. Brandon Mitchell reported that NTIA has no timetable for a proposal.

**Agenda Item 1.21** – *(15 GHz Radiolocation)* – There was no update for this agenda item.

**Agenda Item 8.2** – *(Future Agenda Items)* – Joe Cramer introduced a proposal for a new agenda item for the WRC-15 agenda on wireless avionics intra-communications (WAIC) systems and an associated Resolution (Document IWG-1/32). This document was briefly discussed and then tabled for further discussion at the next IWG-1 meeting.
