On June 10th, 2010, Shure Incorporated (“Shure”) met with Charles Mathias, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Baker to discuss ET Docket No. 04-186 and WT Docket Nos. 08-166 and 08-167. Attending this meeting on behalf of Shure were Mark Brunner, Senior Director, Global Public Relations, and Catherine Wang and Tim Bransford of Bingham McCutchen LLP, outside counsel to Shure.

During this meeting Shure discussed several issues of critical importance to the wireless microphone community pending on reconsideration before the Commission in ET Docket No. 04-186. Shure reemphasized its belief in dynamic access and responsible frequency sharing, and expressed continued support for proven real-world technologies that advance these goals. Shure discussed a number of developments concerning cognitive radio and geolocation database technology. Shure also stressed the need for expanded wireless microphone license eligibility to ensure comprehensive protection for important wireless microphone operations in the geolocation database.
