Meeting Summary: The Chair welcomed everyone to the ninth meeting of IWG-1, and participants introduced themselves. The agenda (Document IWG-1/34) was approved. Joe Cramer (Boeing), once again, volunteered to draft the minutes of this meeting. The minutes of the previous IWG-1 meeting were approved.

The WRC-12 Advisory Committee meeting will be held July 28, 2010. Given this late date, Brandon Mitchell (NTIA) informed the group that any new industry proposals passed by the WAC would not be considered in time for the upcoming CITEP PCCII meeting in August. It was stated that moving the WAC earlier might help this process.

The group then considered contributions under the various WRC agenda items as follows:

**Agenda Item 1.3** – (*UAS*) – There was no update for this agenda item.

**Agenda Item 1.4** – (*AM(R)S*) – The GPS Industry Council document that was *Tabled* at the last meeting was not discussed and will continue to be *tabled* until after the upcoming ITU-R Working Party 5B meeting in May.

**Agenda Item 1.9** – (*Appendix 17*) – The NTIA proposal was discussed. Support for the proposal was expressed by Globe Wireless. The meeting decided to inform the WAC at its next meeting of IWG-1's support for the proposal.

**Agenda Item 1.10** – (*Ship and Port Safety*) – An NTIA proposal for a mobile-satellite service (Earth-to-space) allocation for Appendix 18 channels 75 and 76 to support AIS was discussed and support for the proposal was expressed by the group. An NTIA proposal regarding simplex

use in Appendix **18** was introduced and described. This document was *tabled* in order to allow input and additional discussion and possible approval at the next IWG-1 meeting.

**Agenda Item 1.12** – (37-38 GHz Band) – This proposal is undergoing *Reconciliation*.

**Agenda Item 1.14** – (30-300 MHz Radiolocation) – ARRL's Document IWG-1/31, proposing a no change underscore position on this item. ORBCOMM provided comments on this document which were discussed. It was decided to *table* the document to enable additional discussions to take place among interested parties.

**Agenda Item 1.15** – (3-50 MHz Radiolocation) – There was no input under this Agenda Item.

**Agenda Item 1.21** – (15 GHz Radiolocation) – There was no input under this agenda item.

**Agenda Item 8.2** – (Future Agenda Items) – Boeing provided revisions based upon discussions with several interested parties. Additional changes were suggested at the meeting. The document was *tabled* for further discussion among interested parties.

There was no other business.
