On June 16, 2010, Stacey Black, Assistant Vice President of AT&T Services, Inc. ("AT&T"), Robert Vitanza, General Attorney of AT&T Services, Inc. and the undersigned, met with Jennifer Manner, Behzad Ghaffari and Gene Fullano. During this meeting, AT&T discussed the prospect for funding sources for the development of public safety devices and that these public safety devices should include Bands 2 and 5 in addition to Band 14 to allow for inter-operability with existing 3G Networks. AT&T also indicated that a realistic timeline to develop such as device would be approximately 18 months.
