
As chairwoman of the Greater Waterbury Cable Advisory Council in Connecticut and an active member of my community, I am writing to offer support for the proposed venture of NBC Universal with Comcast and to make the FCC aware of all of the positive contributions that Comcast makes in the Waterbury area on a regular basis.

I know first-hand of Comcast's commitments throughout Connecticut in my capacity as chairwoman of the local cable advisory council. Consider that in Connecticut, Comcast has provided more than \$500,000 in courtesy broadband and video services to libraries, municipal buildings, and schools in the year 2008 alone.
