Since 1979, the Pennsylvania Cable Network (PCN) has been providing educational programming to the citizens of Pennsylvania. We describe ourselves as "A Cable Network Responsive to the Interests and Needs of Pennsylvania and its People." Comcast is our largest cable service provider, and we would like to applaud the assistance Comcast provides.

PCN began by broadcasting educational programming provided by Penn State in conjunction with several universities throughout the state. Today, we offer a broad spectrum of public service programs, including gavel-to-gavel coverage of the state legislature – Pennsylvania's version of C-SPAN.

PCN is funded by Pennsylvania cable television companies that voluntarily carry the service on their channel lineups. The network receives no state or federal funds.
