Re: Petition of AT&T Inc. for Settlements Stop Payment Order on the U.S.-Tonga
Route (IB Docket No. 09-10)

Dear Mr. Ball:

On behalf of Digicel USA, Inc. ("Digicel USA"), I am responding to your letters of April 15 and May 11, 2010.

First, this will confirm, as we discussed, that Digicel (Tonga) Limited ("Digicel Tonga") is not a subsidiary of Digicel USA. I am enclosing for your information a corporate organizational chart reflecting the respective ownership chains of Digicel USA and Digicel Tonga within the Digicel corporate group. You will see from the attached that Digicel USA is a direct subsidiary of Digicel Jamaica Limited. Digicel Tonga is a direct subsidiary of Digicel Pacific Finance Limited. The two companies have a common parent organization, several tiers removed from Digicel USA, in Digicel Group Limited.

In response to your request for information regarding whether Digicel USA and Digicel Tonga are jointly involved in the provision of service to or from the United States and Tonga, we are researching the existence of any such contractual relationships and will revert to you with the results of our findings.

With respect to Digicel USA's pending request for a protective order, we understand from your recent correspondences that Digicel USA is not mentioned in any of the confidential filings made in this docket, but that a relationship with Digicel Tonga has been identified in the confidential filing made by Telecom New Zealand. Since you have asked about possible relationships between Digicel USA and Digicel Tonga with respect to traffic on the U.S.-Tonga route, Digicel USA believes its request for a protective order remains relevant as to the confidential filing made by Telecom New Zealand in response to the International Bureau's request for information in this docket dated February 18, 2009. We hereby renew Digicel USA's request for a protective order granting Digicel USA access to that filing. We further request the

Bureau's written confirmation that no other confidential filings made in response to the Commission's requests for information in this docket to U.S.-registered carriers mention Digicel Tonga. If such mention is made, then Digicel USA's request for a protective order will apply, as well, to such other confidential filings. Thank you for your assistance on this matter.
