The purpose of this letter is to supplement the above-captioned application ("Application"), as requested by its staff. Specifically, staff has asked the parties to confirm the following information.


The parties confirm that the last sentence in the response to (a)(7) on page 7 of the Application should be revised to insert the word "neither" before the second occurrence of Transferee, such that the sentence should read, "To Transferee's knowledge, neither Transferee, nor its attributable investors, has any affiliation with any entities that provide telecommunications services."

The parties also confirm that there are no persons or entities that hold a 10% or greater direct or indirect interest in ALEC, Inc. or Integrated Broadband Services, LLC other than those already disclosed in the application.
