



As someone who has held elected office for the past eighteen years in the Michigan State Senate, Michigan State House and as Clerk of Gaines Township, I know from personal experience that good government is essential for sustaining communities but cannot solve every problem. I appreciate this opportunity to offer you and the Commission my views on the joint venture proposed by Comcast and NBC Universal.



I appreciate this opportunity to offer you and the Commission my views on the joint venture proposed by Comcast and NBC Universal.


