On June 25, 2010, Rosaline Crawford of the National Association of the Deaf, Lise Hamlin of the Hearing Loss Association of America, Judy Harkins and Linda Kozma-Spytek of the Gallaudet University Technology Access Program, Cathy Novelli and Josh Tenuta of Apple Inc., and Paul Margie and Rob Carter on behalf of Apple met with Karen Peltz Strauss, Deputy Chief of the Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau. During this meeting, the parties discussed the challenges of creating hearing aid compatible touch-screen GSM phones, the difficulty of achieving hearing aid compatibility for legacy 2G networks using the 1900 MHz band, and the *de minimis* exception to the hearing aid compatibility rules.
