I have proudly served the City of Philadelphia as a member of their City Council since 1992. Through the years I have had numerous opportunities to engage with Comcast. Given the company's continued commitment to the city and our residents, I respectfully ask you approve its proposed partnership with NBC Universal.

Philadelphia, like most industrial-based northeastern cities, needs to develop a new and sustainable business base, Comcast could have left Philadelphia and established its headquarters elsewhere.
