Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter is to inform you that on June 28, 2010, Vonya McCann, Senior Vice President of Government Affairs for Sprint Nextel Corporation ("Sprint") and the undersigned met with Edward Lazarus and Zachary Katz to discuss the regulatory challenges facing Sprint.

Sprint discussed the importance of preserving a robust competitive environment for wireless services. Sprint noted that although it was reviewing the Commission's proposals on reclassification of broadband services, the Commission has a critical role to play in ensuring that wireless competition continues into the broadband world of the future. In particular, Sprint emphasized the need to ensure access to data roaming and IP/VoIP interconnection. Sprint also discussed its view of the open Internet principles outlined in the Commission's Open Internet NPRM. Finally, Sprint reiterated its support for the Commission's proposal for the auctioning of the 700 MHz "D-Block" spectrum. Sprint's comments were consistent with its filings in the above referenced dockets.
