Dear Ms. Dortch:

The Massachusetts Department of Telecommunications and Cable (“MDTC”) respectfully submits this filing in compliance with the requirement that states and Telecommunications Relay Services (“TRS”) providers submit annual consumer complaint log summaries by July 1 of each year.¹ This submission constitutes the MDTC’s TRS consumer complaint log summary filing for the 12-month period ending on May 31, 2010.

During the period of June 1, 2009, to May 31, 2010, the MDTC did not receive any consumer complaints alleging a violation of federal TRS minimum standards. All complaints were made directly to the state’s TRS provider, Hamilton Relay (“Hamilton”). Hamilton’s log summary is included with this letter as an electronic attachment.
