This letter is to inform you that on July 7, 2010, Vonya McCann, Senior Vice President of Government Affairs for Sprint Nextel Corporation (“Sprint”) and the undersigned met with Joel Gurin, Mark Stone, Julie Saulnier, and Yul Kwon, of the Consumer & Government Affairs Bureau, regarding the above-referenced proceedings.

Sprint discussed its improvements in customer care and the steps it has taken to increase customer satisfaction. Sprint also discussed its disclosure practices, including the manner in which it discloses early termination fees (ETFs), makes usage information available, and provides copies of its terms and conditions to customers. Sprint also provided information on parental controls and its efforts to provide educational materials related to safe use of the internet. Sprint’s comments were consistent with its written pleadings in the above referenced dockets.
