On July 7, 2010, Paul Kershisnik, Chief Marketing Officer and Michael Maddix, Director of Government and Regulatory Affairs of Sorenson Communications, Inc. ("Sorenson"), Antoinette Cook Bush, and the undersigned, of this firm, spoke with Edward P. Lazarus, Chief of Staff, and Sherrese Smith, Legal Advisor to Chairman Julius Genachowski, and Paul de Sa, Chief of the Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis. In this meeting we discussed Sorenson's company history and its involvement in Video Relay Service ("VRS"). We presented a short video demonstration of VRS services similar to those found at http://www.sorensonvrs.com/vrs_demo and pointed out the benefits to the deaf and hard-of-hearing from the advances in technology made by Sorenson.

We discussed the Commission's recent decision to establish an interim VRS compensation rate of \$5.07 for Tier III providers and how that rate would force Sorenson to make changes in its service which could have a detrimental impact on VRS users. We also reviewed financial issues that were detailed in the "Motion for Stay of Sorenson Communications, Inc." in GC Docket No. 03-123, filed June 30, 2010 and requested that the Commission grant that stay.
