SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION OF TIME WARNER CABLE INFORMATION SERVICES (TEXAS), LLC

Time Warner Cable Information Services (Texas), LLC d/b/a Time Warner Cable ("TWCIS (TX)") hereby requests authority pursuant to Section 214(a) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 214(a), and Section 63.71 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, to discontinue the provision of circuit-switched domestic telecommunications services to business customers in the Dallas/Ft. Worth area in Texas.¹ TWCIS (TX) requests that the Commission accept this application for streamlined treatment.

TWCIS (TX) provides the following information in support of this application pursuant to Section 63.71 of the Commission's rules:

I. SECTION 63.71(A)(1)-(4) INFORMATION

¹ The instant application applies only to circuit-switched services offered by TWCIS (TX). Nothing herein should be construed to imply that other services provided by TWCIS (TX) or any of its affiliates constitute "telecommunications services."

B. Date of Planned Service Discontinuance:

TWCIS (TX) plans to discontinue the services described herein on or after August 12, 2010.

C. Geographic Areas Affected:

Affected customers are located in the following communities in Texas: the Dallas/Ft. Worth area

D. Brief description of type of service affected:

TWCIS (TX) seeks authority to discontinue the provision of certain U.S. domestic circuit-switched local services to business customers in the Geographic Area Affected described in Section I.C above. Approximately twenty (20) customers will be affected.

II. NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

TWCIS (TX) notified all affected customers of this proposed discontinuance by letter via U.S. mail on June 7, 2010. The customer notice letter is attached as *Exhibit A*. The notifications informed customers of the discontinuance of the circuit-switched service offering and informed them of the other local service providers offering service in the area. All notifications included or will include the content required by Section 63.71(a).

TWCIS (TX) certifies that, concurrent with the filing of this Application, it is submitting a copy of this Application to the Governor of the State of Texas, the Public Utility Commission of Texas, and also to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications to the Secretary of Defense, as required by Section 63.71(a).

III. REGULATORY STATUS

TWCIS (TX) is regulated as a non-dominant carrier with respect to the services that it seeks authority to discontinue.

IV. CONCLUSION

Neither the present nor future public convenience and necessity will be adversely affected by this proposed termination of service. Customers have been provided adequate notice, and the public has access to comparable domestic telephone services offered at competitive prices in the affected geographic area.



DISCONTINUANCE OF TRADITIONAL TELEPHONE SERVICE

Dear Valued Customer:

Thank you for being a valued Time Warner Cable customer. This letter is being sent to inform you that we are changing our service offerings and will no longer offer Time Warner Cable Business Local Telephone Service in the Dallas area. As a Business Local Telephone Service subscriber, you will be affected by this change, which is scheduled to take effect on or immediately after August 12, 2010. After that date, you will no longer be able to subscribe to Business Local Telephone Service.

You continue to have a choice for local telephone service and you are free to choose your new provider of service. The Business Local Telephone Service that you currently purchase from Time Warner Cable is also available from XO Communications ("XO"). You may choose to transfer your current service to XO today by calling XO at **1-866-349-0134**. In addition, you have the option to purchase similar telephone services from other providers serving your area, including Time Warner Cable, which does offer other business class telephone products. Regardless of your choice, **we urge you to act quickly to transfer your service to XO or to select a new service provider.**

AT&T is the incumbent local exchange carrier in your area. If you wish to obtain telephone service from AT&T, you should contact an AT&T customer service representative at **1-800-499-7928** to request transfer of your current service from Time Warner Cable to AT&T. If you prefer to obtain telephone service from another local service provider instead of AT&T, you should contact that service provider immediately and request to initiate your new service on or before June 30, 2010. Time Warner Cable will work to ensure that the transition of your current telephone service from Time Warner Cable to another provider is as smooth and seamless as possible.

Unless you transfer your service to XO, AT&T, TWC or another telephone service provider before August 12, 2010, your telephone service will be discontinued and you may lose your current telephone number(s).

This proposed discontinuance of your local telephone service is subject to regulatory approvals by the FCC and the Public Utility Commission of Texas. The FCC will normally authorize this proposed discontinuance of service unless it is shown that

customers would be unable to receive service or a reasonable substitute from another carrier or that the public convenience and necessity is otherwise adversely affected.

If you wish to object, you should file your comments as soon as possible, but no later than 15 days after the Commission releases public notice of the proposed discontinuance. Address them to the Federal Communications Commission, Wireline Competition Bureau, Competition Policy Division, Washington, D.C. 20554, and include in your comments a reference to the § 63.71 Application of Time Warner Cable Information Services (Texas), LLC. Comments should include specific information about the impact of this proposed discontinuance upon you or your company, including any inability to acquire reasonable substitute service.

CONVERTING YOUR LOCAL AND LONG DISTANCE TELEPHONE SERVICE

If you wish to transfer your service to XO, you can call their customer service representatives at **1-866-349-0134**. If you prefer to transfer your service to AT&T or other available service provider, please follow these simple steps:

1. Identify and call your new service provider to:
 - Request local telephone service
 - Choose a new long distance service provider
 - Complete a Letter of Agency or third party verification confirming that you intend to transfer your service
 - Get the installation date when your new service will be active
2. Call Time Warner Cable at **(972) 445-6200** to confirm your service conversion and termination of your current Time Warner Cable Business Local Service.

TAKE ACTION NOW

Please take immediate action to convert your local and long distance telephone service to a provider of your choice. **If you do not transfer your service to XO or to a new service provider by August 12, 2010, your existing phone service will be subject to termination and you may risk losing your current telephone number.** Please take action now to avoid interruption in your service.
