On July 19, 2010, Jan Ternell, Esq., General Counsel of Digicel Jamaica Ltd., Jarleth Burke and Del Smith of Jones Day, and Stefan Lopatkiewicz of Dorsey & Whitney, LLP, met with Mindel de la Torre, James Ball, David Strickland, Susan O'Connell and Kimberly Cook (participating by telephone) of the International Bureau to discuss the above-referenced proceeding. The discussion focused on recent developments regarding the Tonga Government's repeal of a minimum rate for inbound international telephone calls; retail rates charged in the United States by U.S. authorized carriers for calls on the U.S.-Tonga route; the Bureau's consideration of AT&T's proposal that the Bureau undertake enforcement of the Commission's benchmark rate for all U.S.-Tonga traffic sent on both direct and indirect routes; and Digicel USA, Inc.'s pending request for a protective order.
