

As a supporter and community partner of Telemundo T39, it is my pleasure and responsibility to express a comment regarding the merger of NBC Universal and Comcast. CR Strategic Events is a Hispanic woman owned business based in Dallas, Texas practicing in eight of the top ten Hispanic markets in the country. We produce 12-14 Hispanic community focused events a year and count Telemundo as our strongest community partner.

We have worked closely with Telemundo T39 to produce events and programs that inform, educate and provide necessary services to the growing Latino community in North Texas. The team at T39 understands the needs of this growing population and works with many local community organizations to provide informative content and outreach through its programming and external events.

Communicating to and reaching Hispanics is becoming more important as the population shifts to a strongly bilingual community. Families depend on news and information they trust with local attention and strong commitment to their needs. Telemundo and NBC 5 in Dallas meet this need for our Spanish speaking families.

Over the past ten years, I have seen the commitment Telemundo has made to help non-profit organization provide services to disadvantaged families in North Texas. One of the organizations helped through T39's involvement is Mi Escuelita Preschools.

Mi Escuelita Preschools is an educational program focused on children ages 3-5. Housed on seven campuses throughout Dallas, Mi Escuelita teaches children English and social competence which prepares them to enter school with the skills necessary to compete with other students who already know English.

Education is not the only need these children have. Through events, outreach and services these children are provided healthcare, dental care and vision care. Telemundo T39 has been instrumental in helping Mi Escuelita fulfill their mission of taking care of families.
