While I understand that I did file the Form 471 Application outside of the funding window, there were weather related school closings that resulted in my missing the funding window postmark. 4. If you are an applicant, please provide a copy of your appeal to the service provider(s) affected by USAC's decision. If you are a service provider, please provide a copy of your appeal to the applicant(s) affected by USAC's decision.
5. Provide an authorized signature on your letter of appeal.
