On July 27, 2010, I spoke via telephone with Rick Kaplan of the Office of Chairman Julius Genachowski. During our call, I expressed T-Mobile's desire that the pending 700 MHz D block rulemakings move forward to address both the public safety technical issues as well as the auction and licensing rules for the band. I noted that the uncertainty surrounding the 700 MHz D block is disrupting plans of competitive commercial carriers and equipment manufacturers to invest in and develop the band. T-Mobile believes this investment is not only good for the economy and competition but will also benefit public safety with enhanced choice and value to meet their interoperable network build and future handset needs.
