
In accordance with Section 1.1206(b)(1) of the Commission's Rules, the Region 33 (Ohio) 700 MHz. Planning Committee (RPC33) submits this written ex parte filing in the above-captioned proceedings.

RPC33 has reviewed the Ex Parte submission of the State of Delaware submitted to the Commission and dated July 15, 2010. Additionally, we have also reviewed the filings supporting the Delaware Ex Parte, including the filings of the state of Ohio and the Ohio SIEC, both dated July 28, 2010, with whom we work very closely, and endorse all of these filings as important to public safety communications. Accordingly, we request that the Commission do the following.

- A. Do not permit broadband operations in the narrowband voice channel spectrum of the 700 MHz frequency band. This band is critical to the provision of nationwide public safety communications interoperability.

- B. Recognize public safety's requirements and reallocate the D Block from the commercial auction to public safety for broadband communications.
