On July 29, 2010, James W. Cicconi, Senior Executive Vice President External & Legislative Affairs, AT&T Inc., spoke by telephone with Commissioner McDowell. Mr. Cicconi discussed matters relating to potential legislation concerning a regulatory framework for promoting Internet openness. In particular, Mr. Cicconi discussed prohibitions against blocking lawful Internet content; standards for preventing unreasonable discrimination that materially harms consumers or competition; transparent disclosures for service capabilities and limitations; the treatment of broadband IP-based services other than Internet access service; and methods for addressing complaints related to Internet openness. Mr. Cicconi's statements were consistent with AT&T's comments in the above-referenced docket.
