Dear Ms. Dortch:

Yesterday, Howard Janzen, CEO of One Communications Corp. and Raymond Ostroski, General Counsel of One Communications Corp., Julia Strow and the undersigned held separate meetings with (1) Chairman Julius Genachowski, Zac Katz, Paul de Sa, and Sharon Gillett; (2) Commissioner Meredith Baker and Christi Shewman; (3) Commissioner Michael Copps and John Giusti; and (4) Commissioner Mignon Clyburn and Angie Kronenberg. During the meetings, we described the proposed sale of One Communications' subsidiary FiberNet, LLC to Ntelos Inc., explained that the transaction would benefit consumers in West Virginia and described the urgent need for the Commission to complete its review of the transaction as quickly as possible. In addition, we explained that it is critical that the Commission resolve open questions regarding the regulatory treatment of VoIP, including whether access charges apply to the origination and termination of interexchange VoIP. We explained that any decision regarding whether access charges apply to VoIP should be prospective only. Finally, we urged the Commission to release the planned Public Notice initiating an integrated review the wholesale market for local wireline transmission facilities (e.g., legacy copper loops, unbundled packetized loops, and Section 271 UNEs).
