Yesterday, Polaris Wireless, Inc. ("Polaris") representatives Martin Feuerstein, Chief Technology Officer, and the undersigned participated in a telephone conference with Jeff Cohen and Patrick Donovan of the FCC's Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau.

During the conference, Polaris noted six issues of particular interest that would merit further comment in the Commission's ongoing wireless E911 location accuracy proceeding, including: (1) moving toward unified or single standards; (2) improving location accuracy indoors; (3) use of femtocells to improve indoor location accuracy; (4) evaluating location feasibility in the vertical dimension; (5) developments in mobile VoIP; and (6) new location technologies.
