During the review of requirements for the submissions, we've noticed that **"Form 470 must be posted to the SLD section of the USAC web site for at least 28 days before filing Form 471"**. As we've posted our Form 470 very close to Form 471 submission postmark date, 28 days requirement hold us back, and finally we posted Form 471 on 04/21/2010.
