
Dear Madam Secretary:

In accordance with Section 1.1206(b)(1) of the Commission's Rules, the Police Department of the City of Newport News submits this written *ex parte* filing with corrections in the above-captioned proceedings.

I have reviewed the *Ex Parte* submission of the State of Delaware submitted to the Commission and dated July 15, 2010. Additionally, I have also reviewed the filings supporting the Delaware *Ex Parte* and endorse all of these filings as important to public safety communications. Accordingly, I request that the Commission do the following:

- A. Do not permit broadband operations in the narrowband voice channel spectrum of the 700 MHz frequency band. This band is critical to the provision of nationwide public safety communications interoperability.
- B. Recognize public safety's requirements and reallocate the D Block from the commercial auction to public safety for broadband communications.
