On August 11, 2010, the undersigned met with Kris Monteith, Nancy Murphy, Mary Beth Murphy, Allison Neplokh, Steve Broeckaert, Brendan Murray, and Jeff Neumann, all of the Media Bureau, to discuss the above-captioned proceeding. Our consultant, Adam Goldberg of AGP, LLC was also in attendance.

During the meeting, we discussed aspects of our Comments and Reply Comments on the Fourth Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking. We discussed our position on downloadable security, specifically our position as on the ambiguity of the definition of “hardware-oriented” conditional access as expressed in our Reply Comments.

We also discussed the features and benefits of Simulcrypt, consistent with our previous comments in this proceeding. In particular, we described how implementation of Simulcrypt would shore up the CableCARD regime and enable competition in the market to supply AllVid adaptors to MVPDs in a future AllVid system.
