Dear Chairman Genachowski:

I write today to offer my thoughts on the joint venture proposed by Comcast Corporation and NBC Universal. I can share with you the enormous benefits that Richard Stockton College and New Jersey has gained from our relationship with Comcast.

Richard Stockton College is a public, four-year college within the New Jersey system of higher education. We offer baccalaureate level programs in the arts, sciences, and professional studies. A residential college whose students are drawn from throughout the state, Stockton is located at the edge of New Jersey's Pine Barrens, 12 miles northwest of Atlantic City.

As we are the only four-year institution in the geographic area, we take seriously the need to extend our services beyond our campus and into the community. To that end, approximately 25 years ago, we began partnering with Comcast to offer The Stockton Channel, an educational access channel serving residents in Atlantic and Cape May Counties. Tele-courses, college activities and a wide variety of educational and cultural programming are cablecast from our campus.
