REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

US Cable of Coastal-Texas, L.P. ("US Cable") respectfully requests a 14-day extension of time, until September 15, 2010, in which to complete and file its FCC Form 477 Local Telephone Competition and Broadband Reports ("Form 477"), currently due on September 1, 2010. As explained in more detail below, US Cable has experienced severe and unexpected technical problems, which have affected its ability to compile accurate data.

In order to provide the detailed broadband service information required on the Form 477, US Cable automated its internal database to allow it to easily extract data on an individual census track basis. However, while preparing the current Form 477 reports, US Cable noticed what appeared to be significant errors in the data. Upon further investigation, US Cable determined that its database had been corrupted and that the census track information for a large number of its broadband service areas are inaccurate.

US Cable is fully aware of the critical importance of the broadband data being sought by the FCC on the Form 477, and the submission of inaccurate information would most certainly undermine the purpose of that data collection. US Cable is working

diligently to recompile the information lost as a result of the corruption of its internal database and is committed to submitting its Form 477 reports as quickly as possible. Nonetheless, due to the unexpected technical problems beyond its control, additional time is required. A grant of the requested extension would benefit the public interest by providing US Cable sufficient time to ensure the completeness and accuracy of its data.

In conclusion, for the foregoing reasons, US Cable respectfully requests the Commission grant it a 14-day extension of time to submit its Form 477 filings currently due September 1, 2010. If the Form 477 reports are completed prior to expiration of the 14-day extension, they will be submitted at that time.
