Dear Ms. Dortch:

On September 1, 2010, Steven K. Berry, President and CEO of the Rural Cellular Association (RCA), Tim Donovan, Director, Legislative Affairs for RCA, and the undersigned met with John Giusti to discuss the FCC's possible new E911 location accuracy benchmarks. RCA requests that the Commission provide an exemption from the new E911 location policy benchmarks to carriers with less than 1 million subscribers and a favorable waiver policy for carriers with less than 10 million subscribers. A complete copy of RCA's E911 location accuracy proposal is attached to this *ex parte* notification.

In addition to E911 location accuracy, RCA asked for a status updated on the FCC's progress on USF reform.
