Stanford Springel as Chapter 11 Trustee (“Trustee”) for the Bankruptcy Estate of Innovative Communication Corporation (“New ICC”), and National Rural Utilities Cooperative Finance Corporation (“CFC”) hereby request an extension of time, through December 2, 2010, to consummate the transfer of control of seven Cable Television Relay Service Authorizations (the “CARS Licenses”). The FCC consented to the acquisition by CFC of the wireline, wireless, and cable television businesses owned and operated by New ICC and by its subsidiaries in the U.S. Virgin Islands on December 7, 2009, including granting consent for the transfer of the CARS Licenses. The Commission previously granted an extension until September 3, 2010 to complete the transaction. The CARS Licenses and file numbers associated with the transfer of control are:

The Trustee and CFC obtained final bankruptcy court approval of the proposed sale on August 17, 2010. However, due to the complex nature of the transaction, court scheduling, and judicial challenges in other jurisdictions, the parties will be unable to consummate the transaction by September 3, 2010. The parties are now seeking to resolve these issues and thereafter will expeditiously consummate the sale of the wireline, wireless, and cable television businesses owned by New ICC.

Therefore, the Trustee and CFC request a 90-day extension of time, *i.e.*, through and including December 2, 2010, to consummate this transaction. For the reasons indicated above, the Trustee and CFC respectfully request that the Commission grant the requested extension of time.
